On the whim of the Western Australian government authorities of the day, eighteen Wongutha people were exiled away from their Country and their people and sent a thousand kilometers away, almost to Perth. They were seemingly powerless. They were locked up, trucked off, given inmate numbers in a government compound - their fate was sealed. And then they escaped and walked home.

Drawing on the memories and voices of the Wongai and a range of written documents and testimonies, Carolyn physically retraced the journey and has just launched the 2nd edition of this important record.

In the process Carolyn has encountered the faithfulness of Jesus and how one person and one voice can make a big difference. As the Bible says "the eyes of the Lord range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him" (2 Chronicles 16:9).

Carolyn will be speaking at the South Perth Uniting Sunday Service this weekend and holding a Perth launch of the book in our Angelo St Hall on Thursday 30th March (to be confirmed).
